

PRIVACY NOTICE

At ABM, we take the protection of personal data seriously. In some cases, your personal data, such as license plate number may be automatically collected to make parking easier and more efficient. We may also collect the time and date of when you enter and exit a parking facility, along with the make and model of your vehicle. If you are a monthly parker, we may collect additional basic personal data for proper billing. ABM does not and will not sell your personal data.

We are required to provide you with the following notice prior to the submission of your personal data:

- If you sign up for monthly parking you may have to submit basic personal details to ABM including your name and contact information.
- We will use your personal data only to the extent required to manage the parking experience. For example, we may email you invoices, which would require your email address to be on file, or we may require you to provide us with a credit card number to process any parking fees.
- ABM may share your personal data only with authorized ABM employees, service
 providers such as credit card processors, facility owners, security personnel, or law
 enforcement if required.
- ABM and our service providers will store your personal data for as long as you are a customer, and for the minimum amount of time needed to satisfy legal and business requirements.
- We need to collect this information to provide parking services to you. There is no requirement for you to sign up for a monthly parking account with ABM, and no requirement to park in our garages. If you decide to park with us we must collect this information.

If you are a California consumer you are entitled to additional rights over your personal data.

- You have the right to know about personal data that we have collected and disclosed about you for the past 12 months;
- You have the right to request that we delete the personal data that we have collected about you, though in some cases we are required to store personal data for legal reasons;
- You have the right to not receive discriminatory treatment for exercising the privacy rights conferred by the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA).
